Australian Veterans National Championships Launceston 14 – 21 September Item provided by Ray Sheath

On Friday the 13th September Mark Page, Neil Hoolihan and Ray Sheath left NZ to attend the Australian Veterans National Championships that were being held in Launceston, Tasmania.

We arrived into Launceston at 8.30pm on Friday night.

The tournament began with play at 9am for the O30 team that comprised Mark, Barry Griffiths and Craig Dye from Canterbury. These guys made the final of this grade, eventually losing to Victoria in the final. They played extremely well and lost 6-5. Mark played unbelievably. There were 12 teams also in this grade. A former French professional played for South Australia and was undefeated.

The 060 team comprised Neil Hoolihan, Ray Sheath (capt) and Gregg Davey from Canterbury. Some days we played matches against different states 2 in a row, meaning we started at 1pm, finished the first match at 4.50pm and then commenced our 2nd match at 5pm and finished just after 9pm !!! There were 12 teams entered in our division, we qualified to play off for places 5-8 We played Victoria for the right to play off for 5th and 6th, they beat us, however the match was tight and Gregg Davey injured his tricep. This caused us to default for the 7th and 8th place, so we came 8th. The standard of play was extremely high, with numerous players having represented Australia at Elite level previously and were ranked extremely high.

All teams matches comprised 3 singles each and 2 doubles. So loads of matches !! Pool play saw both Ray and Neil qualify out of the pool with some great wins. In the first round Ray was drawn against Sharad Pandit, who beat Barry Griffiths last year and again this year. A former pro player in Germany ! Barry had me watching youtube for hours before my match, I eventually lost 12/10, 11/3, 11/9. Neil won his first round, but lost in the following round.

In the 030, Mark lost in the 1/4 final to a player from Victoria. The players that made the final, Mark had beaten one in the teams and lost an extremely close match in the teams to the eventual winner!!

We all thoroughly enjoyed the tournament and have vowed to return again next year with a few more of our Waikato players !! We played circa 50 matches in the tournament each, so we returned to NZ a little worse for wear, but proud of our efforts.

Nominations for the Athol Attwood Cup 2024



The Athol Attwood Memorial Cup was commissioned in 2023, by the committee, to be presented in honour of Athol Attwood who passed away in late 2022 aged 96

He was basically Hamilton table tennis in the late 1960s and 1970s, and it was largely through his drive and initiative that the current Stadium, that we all use today, was built. Our Stadium, opened in 1975, is named after him. Even though he did not play much himself, he had an incredible capacity for work and attention to detail, which ensured everything he was involved with ran smoothly. WkTTA are immensely grateful for his contribution to table tennis in Hamilton and the wider Waikato region.

The criteria for the successful recipient is "In recognition of the individual's outstanding contribution in promoting, enhancing and inspiring table tennis within the Waikato".
