

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR USE OF THIS STADIUM

I will:

- respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of gender, ability or cultural background
- communicate with others in a way that is honest and considerate
- behave professionally, responsibly and ethically, at all times
- comply with requirements around the use of the stadium and treat the facilities, furniture and equipment with respect

I will not:

- behave in a way that is discriminatory, bullying, harassing, racist, sexist, violent, abusive or otherwise inappropriate towards others, in person or online
- arrive at the venue or play while intoxicated
- use bad language towards others, nor will I harass or intimidate players, coaches, officials or spectators.

Administrators, Officials and Coaches

I will:

- remember that players participate for enjoyment and winning is only part of the fun
- ensure that the time players spend with me is a positive experience. All players deserve equal attention and opportunities
- never ridicule or yell at players for making a mistake or not winning
- be reasonable in my demands on players' time, energy and enthusiasm
- support and respect WkTTA committee members, officers and club runners
- display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with the sport including opponents, referees, coaches, officials, administrators, the media, parents and spectators. I will encourage my players to do the same
- be impartial, consistent, objective and courteous when making decisions
- avoid any situations which may lead to or be construed as a conflict of interest

Parents and spectators

I will:

- encourage my child to play within the rules and respect officials' and coaches' decisions
- teach my child to respect their opponent
- remember that children learn best by example so I will applaud good play by both my child's team and their opponents
- give positive comments that motivate and encourage continued effort
- support my child's efforts and performance

I will not:

- pressure my child in any way I know that this is their game not mine
- criticise or ridicule my child's performance during or after the game.



GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR USE OF THIS STADIUM

Players

I will:

- always play by the rules
- never argue with an official. If I disagree with a decision I will inform the captain, coach or manager during a break or after the competition
- control my temper. I understand that verbal abuse of officials and other players or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted behaviour in any sport
- work equally hard for myself and my team
- treat all players in my sport as I like to be treated. I will not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor
- cooperate with my coach, team-mates and opponents
- be a good sport and display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat

Failure to adhere to this Code of Conduct may result in the person being required to leave the stadium. Further disciplinary action may also result.
