How we use your personal information

We use your personal information:

- to verify your identity and uniquely identify you as a member (as applicable)
- to provide products and services to you

- to notify you of upcoming competitions and events
- In event of an accident/ incident to advise next of kin

Sharing personal information

We may disclose your personal information to:
